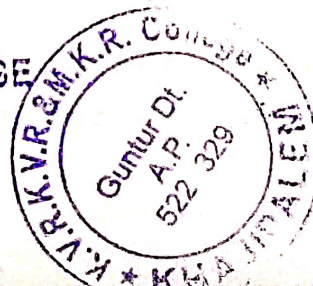

IQAC Core – Group Meetings

During the academic year 2021-22, IQAC has conducted 6 core group meetings. The agenda of the meetings focused on the Action plan, Research Orientation, Teaching, Learning, Innovative methods, Guest lectures, Inter-University Competitions, Intra

University Competitions, Skill Development Programmes, Certificate Courses, Extension activities by the staff to the society and to make the feedback mechanism more effective. Meetings were held with HODs of departments, and faculty members on the need for institutional excellence.

Plan of Action by IQAC/Outcome for the Academic Year 2021-2022

The plan of action chalked out by the IQAC at the beginning of the academic year 2021-2022 towards quality enhancement and respective outcomes were:

Plan of Action and Outcome

I. Plan of Action: To increase the number of research publications in peer-reviewed journals like Scopus and other UGC-listed journals.

Achievement/Outcome: The number of research publications in UGC Listed Journals in 2021-22 is 03.

II. Plan of Action: To continue registration of online courses like MOOCs.

Achievements/Outcome: Number of students registered and completed MOOCs is 18.

III. Plan of Action: To submit AQAR for the academic year 2020 -21.

Achievement/outcome: AQAR for the academic year 2020-2021 was submitted on 12 May 2022 to NAAC Bangalore.

IV. Plan of Action: To encourage staff to register for M.Phils/Ph.Ds. and to apply for Minor Research Projects, NET & SLET

Achievement/Outcome: 3 staff members has registered for M.Phils/Ph.Ds during the last five years of which 01 was awarded with M.Phil and 02 were awarded with Ph.D in Chemistry & English Departments.

V. Plan of Action: To conduct an Internal Academic audit every 6 months.

Achievement/Outcome : An Internal Academic Audit of all the departments is conducted every 6 months by IQAC members.

VI. Plan of Action: To help departments to document quality enhancement activities regularly.

Achievement/Outcome: Given suggestions and assisted all the Departments to document their activities regularly.

VII. Plan of Action: Continuous implementation of Value Added Courses/ Certificate Courses and Career Oriented Courses.

Achievement/Outcome: Certificate Courses on Communication Skills, Analytical Skills, Accounting Skills, Electronic Skills, Electrical Skills, Water Analysis, and Computer Skills are offered free of cost to Degree students by the Departments of English, Mathematics, Commerce, Electronics, Physics, Chemistry and Computer Science respectively.

VIII. Plan of Action: To organise more Student advisory meetings to discuss the academic and infrastructure needs of the students.

Achievement/Outcome: Conducted Student advisory Meetings very frequently in the academic year 2021-22.

IX. Plan of Action: To organise an Awareness program on using Central and Digital Libraries for first-year degree students.

Achievement/Outcome: Conducted an awareness Program for first-year students on the usage of Central and Digital Library.

X. Plan of Action: To organise Industry-Academia Innovative practices

Achievement/Outcome: As COVID-19 pandemic Protocols were effective for a part of the academic year, we did not organise Industry-Academia Innovative practices.

XI. Plan of Action: To conduct Society Outreach Programmes and Community Development Programmes like Swachh Bharat, Vanam-Manam, Blood Donation Camp, NSS camp, etc.

Achievement/Outcome: Society Outreach Programmes, Extension activities, and Community Development Programmes are conducted with the support of NSS, NCC, and Women Empowerment Cells. Some of the noteworthy programs are:

- Blood donation camp was conducted with the support of the Red Ribbon Club and NSS as a part of Republic Day Celebrations in which 150 students and staff participated.
- A special Service camp was conducted at Buddham village from 03-03-2022 to 07-03-2022 in which 100 students participated.
- Advised all the departments to conduct extension activities in their relevant fields.

XII. Plan of Action: Measures to be taken to motivate more students towards sports and games.

Achievement/Outcome: Every Year our college organises College Sports Day on 7th December and Training is given to the students to participate in Inter-University, State and National Level Competitions. Due to the Covid pandemic, though the regular schedule was disturbed, to fulfil the objective and to keep up the interest of students, College Sports Day was conducted on 30-03-2022 in the academic year 2021-2022.

XIII. Plan of Action: Training of students towards higher studies and employability through Career Guidance & Placement Cell.

Achievement/Outcome: Conducted a Campus Drive by "Bluepal Solutions pvt Ltd.," in which 16 students participated and 12 students got placed. Competitive Chemistry Coaching to M.Sc(Chemistry) students was started on 03-01-2022 by Sri.G.Naresh Babu, Director of LNIG, Tenali.

XIV. Plan of Action: Strengthening the co-curricular skills of students through competitions.

Achievement/Outcome: Advising Literary Association to encourage students to participate in Quiz, Elocution, and Essay Writing competitions organized by other colleges. Conducted ANU & KU level Intercollegiate Elocution & Essay writing competitions in which 62 students participated.

- Due to the Covid pandemic, Online Classes were conducted through Zoom and Google Meet Apps.
- All the Departments are encouraged to use ICT as a learning resource in the teaching and learning process.
- Staff members are using Digital Class Rooms and Virtual Class Rooms in the Teaching and Learning Process.
- Staff members of different Departments use electronic gadgets such as LCD Projectors, Smart Boards, etc.
- PPT Lessons are prepared by the staff, Video CDs, digital resources, and Internet and Video conferencing facilities were made available for effective teaching and for explaining complicated concepts.

Achievement/Outcome: Conducted remedial Classes for Slow learners regularly.

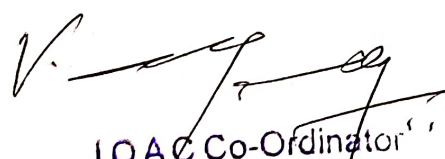

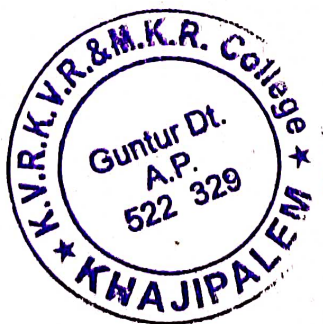

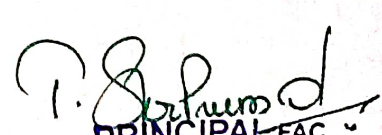
