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## **IQAC REPORT (2019-2020)**

The Indian higher education system is on the brink of great transformations to cope with global competence. This system is one of the third largest higher educational systems in the world, comprising 864 universities and 40,026 colleges, 11,669 stand alone institutions.

Maintaining quality in this system is a matter of long – term initiative. To reach this long-term goal, Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) was established in KVR KVR & MKR College in 2007. The prime responsibility of IQAC is to initiate, plan and supervise various activities that are necessary to increase the quality of education imparted in the college. The role of IQAC in maintaining quality standards in teaching, learning and evaluation is crucial. At present IQAC's main function is to improve research and is taking steps towards it.

In the beginning of academic year 2019-2020, IQAC committee is constituted with the following members.

### **IQAC Core – Group Meetings**

During the academic year 2019-20 IQAC has conducted 5 core group meetings. The agenda of the meetings focused on Action plan, Research Orientation, Teaching, Learning and Innovative methods, , Guest lectures, National & International Seminars/ Workshops, conduction of Society outreach programmes and to make the feedback mechanism more effective. Meetings were held with HOD's of departments, faculty members, students and parents on the need for institutional excellence.
